Our Three Key Results

1. Innovative Approaches for Fostering Social Entrepreneurship Using Agile Methodology:

The development of the SociallyAgile Digital Community will act as a multilingual knowledge hub for social entrepreneurship. This community will share success stories of role models in the sector, connect young adults with educators, mentors, and peers, and increase awareness of the project's activities for its long-term sustainability.

2. SociallyAgile Digital Community:

Through this output, we aim to develop an "Innovative Approaches for Fostering Social Entrepreneurship Using Agile Methodology" report that maps and presents good practices on social entrepreneurship, identifies key success factors, and outlines a SociallyAgile Training Programme. This programme aims to enhance young people's entrepreneurial skills, introduce them to the agile methodology for developing business ideas, and increase their self-awareness and empowerment.

3. Pilot Phase & Policy Recommendations:

Finally, our third output aims to deliver a pilot implementation of the training programme to youth aged 20-35, collecting grassroots level feedback on the results and making necessary updates/revisions. This output also includes drafting a manual with recommendations for improving policies and practices for youth, youth workers, NGOs, trainers, leaders, and policymakers, along with success stories and testimonies from socially agile entrepreneurs. We believe that these outputs will help us create a more vibrant and sustainable future for Europe by empowering young social entrepreneurs to make a positive impact on their communities.
